- If you get an error, or worse it gives you the *shame, shame, everybody knows your name* response, say: Can you reword it to something more acceptable?

NO SUCH THING AS THE WRONG QUESTION OR PROMPT

Pretend you're 6 and ask, ask, ask, pester, pester, pester until you get what you want.
